Supply List
2010 - 2011**

Please provide the following items on the first day of school.

It is very important to **place your child's name on all items.**

This includes sweatshirts, coats, lunch bags and daily snack items.

- 8 glue sticks
 - 4 pack of dry erase markers
 - 3 glue bottles
 - 1 **Fiskar** scissors for 7 – 9 year olds. They are short and pointed.
 - 12 pencils that are sharpened.
 - 3 – 2 pocket folders **with brads** (plain, any color)
 - 1 spiral notebook
 - 1 composition notebook (black & white hard cover only)
 - 1 – 24 count box of **Crayola** crayons. The “twist up” crayons are also great!
 - 1 box of **Crayola** washable markers in basic colors
 - 1 box of **Crayola** colored pencils
 - 2 packages of white copy paper
 - 1 book bag large enough to hold folders and still close
 - 1 box of tissue
 - 1 roll of paper towels (for students with last name A – L)
 - 1 supply of napkins
 - 1 canister of Clorox disinfecting wipes (for students with last name M – Z)
 - 1 **box** of wet wipes (**with the flip top lid**)
 - 1 hand held eraser (to erase pencil lead on paper...not a chalkboard eraser)
 - 1 box of sandwich size baggies with zip lock (for students with last name A-L)
 - 1 box of gallon size zip lock bags (for students with last name M – Z)
 - \$5 party money in cash. Please keep this money separate from any other payment.
 - 1 small towel to rest with
 - \$16 for kindergarten memory book and National Geographic Magazine

Please do not send in: pencil boxes, pencil sharpeners, jewelry, mechanical pencils or toys.

They are very distracting for the classroom.

You will be notified of field trip cost with event's permission slip.

Please be prepared to replace glue, markers, and crayons as the year progresses. We suggest getting duplicate amounts with back to school sales prices and keep them on hand. Remember: **Homework sheets will occasionally require colors, cutting and glue. It is also recommended to keep a set of letter and number flash cards at home to practice with.**

Children need to be fluent with letter and number identification!!
